Race Format

(As of 23rd November, 2020)

A. Race lane allocation:

1. The race lane draw in blocks will be conducted at Team Manager briefing. This is a two-boat race event.
2. Each block contains 8 boats. Boat 1 will take Lane 4 and boat 2 will take lane 6. Conceptually, all boats in odd number will take lane 4 and boats in even number will take lane 6 in subsequent races of Round 1.
3. For Round 2, the winning teams will take lane 4.
4. The Semi-Final race lane allocation will be assigned as following;
 - i. Semi-Final 1 - Winner in Race 5 will take lane 4. Winner in Race 6 will take lane 6.
 - ii. Semi-Final 2 - Winner in Race 7 will take Lane 4. Winner in Race 8 will take Lane 6.
5. The Final race lane allocation will be assigned as following;
 - i. Winner in Race 9 will take up lane 4. Winner in Race 10 will take up lane 6.
6. Refer to the Section C - Race Progression Format for the race lane allocation.

B. Race cancellation:

In the event the organizer needs to cancel races to maintain a feasible race timeline, the following races will be cancelled based on the order of priority:-

1. All Round 2

If all of Round 2 cannot be completed due to inclement weather, progression to Semi-Finals determined by;

- Winner in Race 1 will race with winner in Race 2.
- Winner in Race 3 will race with winner in Race 4.

2. All Semi-Finals

If all of Semi-Finals cannot be completed due to inclement weather, progression to Finals determined by latest completed results;

2.1 If all Round 2 completed;

- Two winners in Round 2 ranked by their finishing time.

2.2 If all Round 1 completed;

- Two winners in Round 1 ranked by their finishing time.

3. Final

If Final is cancelled, the winner and Runner-Up will be determined by latest completed available results;

3.1 If all Semi-Final completed;

- Best finishing time in Semi-Final will be the winner of the Block
- Second best finishing time in Semi-Final will be the Runner-up of the Block

3.2 If all Round 2 completed;

- Best finishing time in Round 2 will be the winner of the Block
- Second best finishing time in Round 2 will be the Runner-up of the Block

3.3 If all Round 1 completed;

- Best finishing time in Round 1 will be the winner of the Block
- Second best finishing time in Round 1 will be the Runner-up of the Block

The Organizer reserves the right to adjust, amend, replace and/or even cancel any part of the race schedule, program or format to suit the new schedule and race conditions due to inclement weather.
