4 RACE BY-LAWS

| 4.1 | Eligibility | This race is open to SDBA's affiliates and associate members |
| 4.2 | Registration | <p>a) Registration shall be on a first-to-register, first-to-get-slot principle through SDBA's on-line registration system.</p> <p>b) Each Team can register up to two (2) racing crew per respective category and racing division.</p> <p>c) Priority shall be given to the Team's 1st registered crew however.</p> <p>d) The Team's 2nd crew will only be accepted subjected to the remaining availability of slots after the acceptance of all the other Teams' 1st crew registration.</p> <p>e) Exception is made for the Para Dragon category where each Team can submit more than two (2) racing crew.</p> |
| 4.3 | Minimum Age to Race | Minimum age to race is twelve (12) years old and must be accompanied, inside the dragon boat, by a parent or a responsible adult appointed by the parent. |
| 4.4 | Racing Crew configuration | <p>a) DB12 minimum configuration: 8 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steer + 0 reserves = 10 persons</p> <p>b) DB12 maximum configuration 10 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steer + 2 reserves = 14 persons</p> <p>c) DB22 minimum configuration 16 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steer + 0 reserves = 18 persons</p> <p>d) DB22 maximum configuration 20 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steer + 4 reserves = 26 persons</p> <p>e) DB22 maximum configuration Ring Race configuration only: 20 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steer + 0 reserves = 22 persons</p> |
| 4.5 | Open Racing Class | No restriction on gender or crew composition for the racing crew (i.e. paddlers, drummer and steersperson). |
| 4.6 | Mixed Racing Class | <p>a) DB12 minimum:- 4 male : 4 female</p> <p>b) DB12 maximum:- 5 male : 5 female</p> <p>c) DB22 minimum:- 8 male : 8 female</p> <p>d) DB22 maximum:- 10 male : 10 female</p> <p>e) The Drummer, Steer and Reserves can be of any gender</p> |
| 4.7 | The Racing Crew (Paddler, Drummer, Steer & Reserves) | <p>a) Represent same Team in different category or division on same or different day – <i>PERMITTED</i></p> <p>b) Represent different Teams on same day – <i>NOT PERMITTED</i></p> <p>c) Represent different Teams on different day – <i>PERMITTED</i></p> |
| 4.8 | Back-to-Back Race | <p>a) Beware of possible back-to-back races!</p> <p>b) Boat Marshall shall not wait for the Team to have their full racing crew ready to race</p> |

| 4.9 | Steersperson | <p>a) Minimum requirement for DB12 boat: The Steer must possess the Small Crew Basic Helm license</p> <p>b) Minimum requirement for DB22 boat: The Steer must possess the Basic Helm Probationary Letter</p> <p>c) Note that Small Crew Basic Helm license <u>CANNOT</u> helm the DB22</p> |

| 5.3 | Singapore Youth Mixed | For Tertiary Institution teams |
| 5.4 | Singapore Seniors Mixed | <p>a) Participants must be minimum 40 years old in year of competition</p> <p>b) Exception is made for Drummer or Steersperson</p> |
| 5.5 | Singapore Masters Mixed | <p>a) Participants must be minimum 50 years old in year of competition</p> <p>b) Exception is made for Drummer or Steersperson</p> |
| 5.6 | Singapore Corporate Mixed | <p>a) For Singapore or International registered companies, corporations ; Singapore Statutory Boards and Partly Corporatized Government Entities.</p> <p>b) The Paddlers must be full or part time employees, on permanent or contractual employment.</p> <p>c) Interns are only permitted on a case-to-case basis so please contact The Organizers.</p> <p>d) Coach, Team Manager and Steersperson does not have to be an employee.</p> <p>e) The Staff ID-pass or a letter from the Human Resource Department must be made available upon The Organizer's request on race day.</p> |
| 5.7 | Singapore International Community Mixed | <p>a) For International Dragon Boat Community teams</p> <p>b) DB12 boat: Minimum 4 Singapore citizens or PR in the Crew List (including drummer, steer or reserves)</p> |

| 5.8 | DB22 Singapore National Mixed | <p>a) For all SDBA affiliate or associate member</p> <p>b) For International Community Teams: Minimum 6 Singapore citizens or PR in the Crew List (including drummer, steer or reserves)</p> |
| 5.9 | DB22 Pesta Sukan Open and Mixed Ring Race | <p>c) For all SDBA affiliate or associate member</p> <p>d) For International Community Teams: Minimum 6 Singapore citizens or PR in the Crew List (including drummer, steer or reserves)</p> |
| 5.10 | DB22 Para Dragon | <p>a) Each boat must comprise of minimum eight (8) persons to maximum ten (10) persons with a permanent disability</p> <p>b) Definition of disability shall be in accordance to Singapore's Enabling Master Plan SG Enable classification for physical, sensory, intellectual disabilities and autism</p> <p>c) Refer to https://employment.sgenable.sg/about-us/what-is-disability/</p> <p>d) An able-bodied caregiver/supporter/volunteer may be permitted to accompany the person with disability inside the boat at the ratio of 1:1</p> <p>e) The Adaptive Team must be formed with a cause for a group of special needs society with a vision and plan for inclusivity.</p> <p>f) The Team needs to demonstrate that all participants would have trained together as a team for a period of at least 3 months in the spirit of social cohesion.</p> <p>g) There may be a request for doctor's diagnosis for persons with disabilities (to ensure level playing field).</p> |

7 RACE FORMAT

- 7.1 The Event shall be in Kallang Basin race course
- 7.2 The race shall be minimum 3 teams and up to maximum 5 teams per race
- 7.3 The racing lanes shall be Lane 2 to 5 with Boat #01 in Lane 2 and so on
- 7.4 The race format shall be: Heats > Repechage > Semi Final (if have) > Final OR Direct Final
- 7.5 Ring Race
 - a. 2.5 rounds with 4 turns
 - b. Each straight run = 400m
 - c. Direct Final with up to maximum 10 boats
 - d. Floating chase start
