## 7 KALLANG BASIN RACE COURSE

7.1 The Field-of-Play is the Kallang Basin Race Course ; Back-of-House is at Sports Hub Water Sports Centre

### 7.2 100m & 200m Race Course

a. Racing lanes shall be Lane 2 to 5, with Boat #01 in Lane 2 and so on

b. **Start Procedure:** Hold buoy start



### 7.3 2,000m Race Course

a. 2½ rounds with 4 turns

b. Each straight run = 400m

c. **Start Procedure:** Floating chase start



## 8 ATTIRE/UNIFORM AND RACING EQUIPMENT

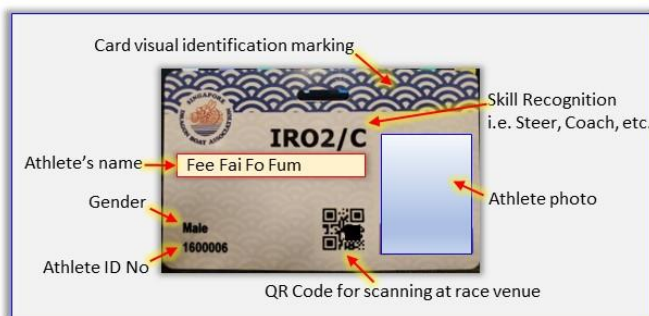
- 8.1 All teams are required to be in same jersey/uniform/attire (i.e. same color, design, etc.). Rash guards, compression-wear and all types of bottoms (i.e. shorts, tights, etc.) are exempted.
- 8.2 Dragon Boat paddles must comply with IDBF standard Type 202a
- 8.3 Personal Floatation Device (PFD) must be ISO 12402-5 standard or equivalent
- 8.4 Teams that do not have own paddles and PFD are required to contact SDBA

- 10.2 **Application Close:** Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> July 2022 ; 1400hrs
- 10.3 Sample of valid SDBA Athlete Card:



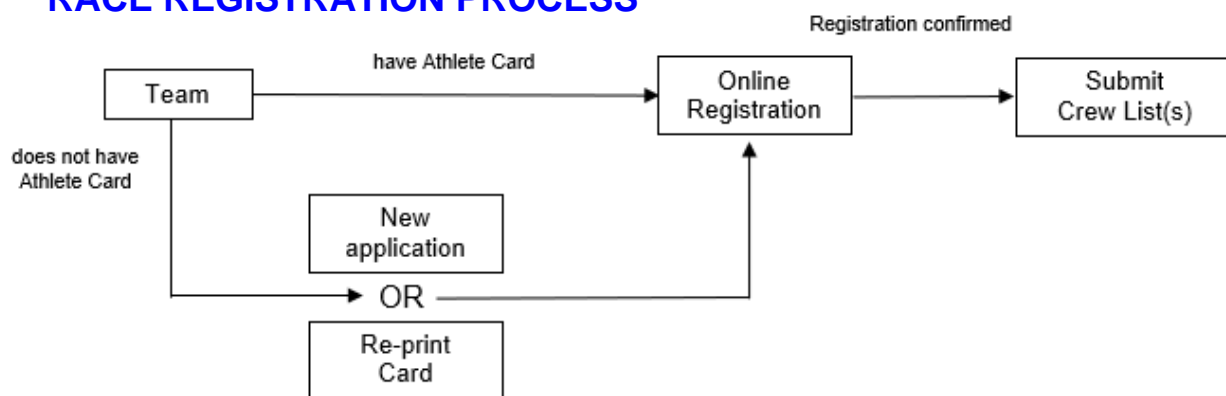
- 10.4 Check whether the Athlete has been issued with an Athlete Card by their former team or by another team:
  - a. **If Yes:** Use the existing card as the Athlete is considered to be already registered
  - b. **If No:** Apply a new card as this will be the first time the Athlete is registered



- 10.5 Apply the new card or re-print existing cards at <https://registration.sdba.org.sg>.
- 10.6 First-time Teams applying for the Athlete Cards are required to create 'Team Manager' account in the system first before proceeding.
- 10.7 For checking of Athlete Card at race venue, the following procedures are accepted:
  - a. Physical athlete card and/or
  - b. E-copy on smart phone or mobile devices
  - c. Note: Both physical and e-copies must able to be scanned at Boat Marshall station

## 12 CREW LIST SUBMISSION PROCESS

- 12.1 **Submission Open:** 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022, 0000hrs
- 12.2 **Submission Close:** 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022, 2359hrs
- 12.3 Teams are required to submit separate Crew List for every racing category or division that they will be participating in
- 12.4 Note that the online system will calculate and check the no. of participants listed in the Crew List vs. total no. of participants registered in the online registration period
- 12.5 You will need to know the Athlete Card no. of every person you intend to register in the Crew List

12.1 Teams shall be required to make payment ONLY after submission of Crew List.

12.2 The amount to be paid shall be based on the final registration amount computed automatically on the on-line team registration form

- 12.3 Withdrawal of Team and/or racing crew after payment has been verified and confirmed:
- a. No refund of the registration fee payment already made
  - b. Admin charge of \$107 for full Team withdrawal
  - c. Admin charge of \$53.50 per racing crew per Team withdrawals
- 12.4 There shall be no refund if whatsoever extra registration fee is paid

### **13 WAIVER OF LIABILITY (FORM F4)**

- 13.1 Waiver of Liability (Form F4) is available in the online Team Registration portal after the Crew List submission is completed.
- 13.2 It is incumbent upon the Team Manager to download and print the Form F4. Team Manager must ensure that all the registered team members signed on the document. This will confirm that each registered team member is aware of their respective rights and liabilities.
- 13.3 Team Managers are required to submit Form F4 in e-format before Race Day or hardcopy on Race Day before the start of The Team's first race.
- 13.4 Team *DID NOT* bring Form F4 for submission on Race Day:
- a. Race Secretary and/or Chief Boat Marshall may re-print Form F4 for the Team at cost of \$53.50
  - b. The Team Manager must then get every person registered on the Crew List to acknowledge and sign-off Form F4
- 13.5 Form F4 is a legal document** so please treat the completion of this form with the utmost seriousness and importance.
- 13.6 Teams that did not submit Form F4 shall be barred from competing.** This shall be treated as a withdrawal and the following shall apply:
- a. No refund of registration fee payment already made
  - b. Admin charge of \$107 for full Team withdrawal
  - c. Admin charge of \$53.50 per racing crew per Team withdrawals

### **14 PROTESTS & APPEAL**

- 14.1 Protests  
A protest against a race result must be made immediately after the result is officially announced.
- 14.2 Appeals  
An appeal against a protest result must be made immediately after the protest result is officially announced.
- 14.3 Protest / Appeal Fees
- a. All protests / appeals shall be made in writing.

b. The protest / appeal form is available at respective pontoon area.

c. Fees Applicable:

d. The protest / appeal fee shall be refunded if the protest/appeal is successful.

## **15 RESERVATIONS**

- 15.1 SDBA reserves the rights to use any print or digital photos as well as videos of participants (as individuals or in a Team) taken by SDBA's officials and or appointed agents for educational, instructional, publicity and/or promotional purpose.
- 15.2 SDBA reserves the right to deny an individual and/or Team, participation in the event not due to infringement of Competition Regulations or Rules of Racing, if the individual and/or Team has any outstanding issues or matters with SDBA, i.e. outstanding disciplinary case, non-race related payments, etc.
- 15.3 SDBA reserves the rights to change, delete, remove, amend, change or adjust in-full or in-part, the racing plan, format, schedule and program as SDBA sees fit, in the interest of maintaining a safe and feasible racing environment and condition, with or without informing the participants the reasons for the changes.
