This Bulletin serves as a Guide for Interest in the SRW. With regards to the racing rules, competition regulations and event management conventions, these shall be finalized and confirmed in the Entry Rules



1. RACE VENUE, RACE COURSE AND DISTANCE

- 1.1. The racing distance is a straight-course 200m.
- 1.2. The racing course is in Kallang Basin via the Singapore Sport Hub Water Sport Centre. The racing course is marked by clearly visible buoys placed in a straight line at intervals down the length of the course. Lane 1 shall be the lane nearest to the location of the Finish Line Judges.
- 1.3. The Start shall be Pontoon Hold-Tail style. This will be finalized again during the Team Manager Briefing.
- 1.4. The Finish shall be at right angles to the Racing Lanes. The Finish shall be marked off of the water by a checker tag board at the outer limits of Lane 6.
- 1.5. There would be no lifeguard on duty for SRW. The Team Manager must familiarise the capsized drill and identify weak swimmers of the team during boat marshalling.

6. RACE FORMAT

- 6.1. Each race shall be according to a max of 5 boat racing concept, per race, per category
- 6.2. The racing lanes that shall be used in Kallang Basin will be Lanes 2 to 6 (with Lane 1 empty). Boat 2 shall be in Lane 2 and so on.
- 6.3. Race Format shall be: Heats -> Repechage -> Semi Final -> Final (whenever feasible) OR a Combine Timing of 2 rounds

7. COMPETITION REGULATIONS & RULES OF RACING

7.1. The race will be in accordance with the IDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing with specific SRW Entry Rules

8. ENTRY FEE

- 8.1. The Entry Fee (inclusive of 9% GST per person, per category):
 - Affiliates Members = \$32.70
 - Associates Members = \$32.70
 - Overseas = \$32.70
 - Non-Affiliates = \$65.40
- 8.2. Entry Fees are waived for the following category
 - a. DB22 PA Para Category
 - b. Secondary school and Junior College
