# 3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

3.1	The Registration	<ul> <li>a) This race is open to all Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges, the Millenia Institute and the International Schools.</li> <li>b) Registration shall be on a first-come-first-get basis through the SDBA's online registration system.</li> <li>c) Each Team can register up to two (2) racing crews per respective category and racing division. (Note that this differs from the Bulletin &amp; will supersede the Bulletin)</li> <li>d) Priority shall be given to the Team's 1<sup>st</sup> registered crew</li> <li>e) The Team's 2<sup>nd</sup> crew will only be accepted subjected to remaining availability of slots after accepting all the First Crew registration.</li> </ul>
3.2	The Inter School Crew	<ul> <li>a) Shall follow Ministry of Education (MOE) National School Games guidelines on age restriction.</li> <li>b) The Coach or staff of the school may steer for the Crew</li> <li>c) The school may also use externally sourced Steers, i.e. non Coach or staff of the school, etc.</li> </ul>
3.3	Boys Racing Class	<ul><li>a) The paddlers and drummer must be ALL-MALE</li><li>b) No gender restriction for the steersperson</li></ul>
3.4	Girls Racing Class	<ul> <li>a) The paddlers and drummer must be ALL-FEMALE</li> <li>b) No gender restriction for the steersperson</li> </ul>
3.5	Open Racing Class	<ul><li>a) No gender restriction for the paddlers, drummer and steersperson.</li><li>b) This is only applicable to the NCC racing category.</li></ul>
3.6	The Crew	<ul> <li>a) The <u>DB12</u> racing crew size and configuration: <ol> <li>Min: 8 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steersperson (total=10)</li> <li>Max: 10 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steersperson + 2 reserves (total = 14)</li> </ol> </li> <li>b) The <u>DB22</u> racing crew size and configuration: <ol> <li>Min: 18 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steersperson (total = 20)</li> <li>Max: 20 paddlers + 1 drummer + 1 steersperson + 4 reserves (total = 26)</li> </ol> </li> <li>c) Paddlers, drummer and reserves must be a student of the Secondary School, Junior College, Millenia Institute and International School in the competition year.</li> </ul>
3.7	The Paddler, Steersperson, Drummer & Reserve	<ul> <li>a) No restriction on participation status BUT be aware of the risk of probable back-to-back races.</li> <li>b) Boat Marshall shall not wait for Team/Crew to have full racing crew ready.</li> <li>c) After Boat Marshall's three(3) calls, the race check-in will be closed and the Unready Team shall forfeit participation OR</li> <li>d) If Team/Crew still meet the minimum requirement of 8 paddlers+1 drummer + 1 steer (total = 10), then they may proceed to race check-in.</li> </ul>

3.8	The	a)	Minimum requirement: SDBA Basic Helm Certificate.
	Steersperson	b)	For DB12 only: SDBA Small Crew Basic Helm Certificate.
3.9	Minimum Age to Race	a) b)	Minimum age for Paddlers, Drummer and Reserves must comply with MOE's controls on age grouping for A, B and C inter school divisions. Steersperson must be minimum 18 years of age in the competition year.

# 4. ATTIRE / UNIFORM AND RACING EQUIPMENT

- 4.1 All teams are required to be in same jersey/uniform/attire (i.e. same color, design, etc.). Rash guards, compression-wear and all types of bottoms (i.e. shorts, tights, etc.) are exempted.
- 4.2 The jersey of the external steersperson is also to be in the same uniform unless the steersperson is provided by SDBA, which he/she will be in a SDBA uniform.

#### 5. RACE COURSE AND DISTANCE


- 5.1 The racing distance is 200m unless stated otherwise.
- 5.2 The racing course is at the Bedok Reservoir. The racing lanes is a straight stretch of water, marked by clearly visible buoys placed in a straight line at intervals down the length of the racecourse.
- 5.3 This is a max. 5 racing lane race.
- 5.4 The Start shall either be Hold-Buoy or Floating style.

# 6. RACE PROGRESSION FORMATS

Race Format shall be:

Heats -> Repechage -> Semi Final -> Final (whenever feasible) OR 2 rounds of Finals where their timings are combined to determine the winner.

# 9 ONLINE RACE REGISTRATION

- 9.1 There shall be *no registration fee* for this race.
- 9.2 Team Managers must verify that they have the Up-to-date <u>ATHLETE CARD NUMBER of EVERY PERSON</u> that the Team intend to register.
- 9.3 Teams that are using the Steerspersons provided by SDBA on race day, can leave this part blank in the registration portal
- 9.4 Team Managers are required to fill-up online Form F2: Team Registration which is registration-bynumbers only. The Team Manager is required to:
  - a) indicate number of participants
  - b) indicate the racing category/division that the team intends to participate.

# 11 PROTESTS AND APPEALS

## 11.1 Protests

- a) Protest can be lodged at either Race Secretary or Boat Marshall and made immediately after the race or official posting of the race result.
- b) All Protests shall be addressed to the Race Committee (Chief Official, Chief Judge & Chief Umpire).

### 11.2 Appeals

- a) An appeal against the protest or protest outcome can be lodged at either the Race Secretary or Boat Marshall and made immediately after the official reply to the Protest.
- b) All Appeals shall be addressed to the Race Jury. Decision of the Race Jury is final.

# 11.3 Protest / Appeal Fees

- a) All protests / appeals shall be made in writing. The protest / appeal form is available at Race Secretary area.
- b) Fees Applicable: protest/appeal Fee: <u>\$50 in cash</u>
- c) The protest/appeal fee shall be refunded if the protest/appeal is successful.

- 13.1 SDBA will be offering the use of 4 boats (either DB12/DB22) without cost, for each school per Division. Subsequent usage of additional boats are chargeable.
- 13.2 Schools are strongly urged to utilize these opportunities to get their students be familiarized with the sport.
- 13.3 Please note that should the school require SDBA to provide Trainer and/or Steersperson, it is chargeable at \$75/pax (before GST), subject to availability of the Trainer / Steersperson.
- 13.4 When booking for the boats, please specify "NIS/<u>School Name</u>/Session 1/DB12orDB22 required". Otherwise, <u>SDBA will proceed to bill the school for the use of boats</u>.
