SAFE USE OF MARINA RESERVOIR: Other Reservoirs: Check with the respective Operators

Min. 5 persons in DB12 OR 9 persons in DB22 boats:

- 1) Not advisable to enter Marina Channel and Geylang River
- 2) General reduction of 60% in Power to Weight ratio
- 3) The boat may encounter difficulties negotiating strong winds, swift currents and high waves. In case of a capsize, more difficult for The Crew to recover the boat
- 4) Teams are advised to fulfil the following Lesser Crew requirement to enter marina Channel or Geylang River:
 - a) 7 persons in DB12 (6 paddlers + 1 Coach-cum-Steer or Steer)
 - b) 11 persons in DB22 (10 paddlers + 1 Coach-cum-Steer or Steer)

General Requirements:

- 1) Keep sight of the Lightning Warning System beacons (see map)
- Return to base if you encounter dangerous situations (i.e. Cat 1 weather / lightning strikes) or emergencies (i.e. medical or damage to the boat)
- 3) If deemed critical or life-threatening, go to nearest designated Safe Harbours and Emergency Landing Points
- 4) If moving crew inside the boat, **stabilize the boat first by Bracing**
