The Entry Rules is to be read in conjunction with SDBA's Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing. Unless otherwise stated, this event will be governed by SDBA's Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing. For any matter arising not found in the SDBA's Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing, it will be referred to IDBF Competition Regulations and Rules of Racing.

#### 1.1 Reservation of Exclusive Rights

- a) The Singapore Regatta Waterfest2023 is jointly organized by the Singapore Dragon Boat Association (SDBA) & Kallang Alive Sport Management Co. Pte Ltd (KASM). KASM manages the Water Sports Centre & the National Stadium in Sportshub.
- b) SDBA reserves the rights to technical and race management & KASM reserves the rights to venue management.
- c) SDBA & KASM may cancel any race categories if the number of racing crew registered for the category/division is three (3) racing crew or less. The minimum number of racing crew required for the category/division to be raced shall be four (4) racing crew.

- d) SDBA reserves the right to accept and/or allocate available slots of each racing division. If the registration for the respective race categories exceeded their slots, Teams that registered beyond the slot shall be put on the "Pending" list until confirmed/rejected by the Race Committee.
- e) SDBA may refuse any entry at her sole discretion and shall adjust the race format, schedule or program accordingly.

# 2 RACE VENUE, RACE COURSE AND DISTANCE

- 2.1. The racing distance is a straight-course 200m.
- 2.2. The racing course is in Kallang Basin via the Singapore Sport Hub Water Sport Centre. The racing course is marked by clearly visible buoys placed in a straight line at intervals down the length of the course. Lane 1 shall be the lane nearest to the location of the Finish Line Judges.
- 2.3. The Start shall be Pontoon Hold-Tail OR Drummer Hold-Buoy style. This will be confirmed in the Team Manager Briefing.
- 2.4. The Finish shall be at right angles to the Racing Lanes. The Finish shall be marked off of the water by a checker tag board at the outer limits of Lane 6.
- 2.5. Field-of-Play



#### 3 CREW COMPOSITION

#### 3.1 The Crew

- a) Minimum Age to Race is twelve (12) years old and must be accompanied, inside the dragon boat, by a parent or a responsible adult appointed by the parent.
- b) Open Racing Class No restriction on gender or crew composition.
- c) Women Racing Class Entire Crew must be ALL-WOMEN in the SRW Women racing category and class. In the POLITE, Tertiary, Corporate and IDBC Women categories, a Male-steersperson is permitted.

#### d) Standard 22 Crew Racing Boat (DB22)

- i. The crew shall consist of 20 paddlers, 1 drummer, 1 steersperson plus 4 reserves for a maximum of 26 athletes.
- ii. The minimum number of paddlers allowed to race in the DB22 is 18 paddlers (i.e., 18 paddlers, 1 drummer, 1 steersperson, etc.)

# e) Small 12 Crew Racing Boat (DB12)

- i. The crew shall consist of 10 paddlers, 1 Drummer, one 1 Steersperson plus 2 reserves for a maximum of <u>14 athletes</u>.
- ii. The minimum number of paddlers allowed to race in the DB12 is 8 paddlers (i.e., 8 paddlers, 1 drummer, 1 steersperson, etc.)

#### 3.3 The Mixed Crew

#### a) DB22 Mixed categories:

i. Permissible gender ratio for the DB22 Mixed crew, excluding Reserves:-

- ii. Maximum no of paddlers in the DB22 Mixed crew (excluding Drummer & Steersperson) permitted, is twenty (20) paddlers based on the gender ratio in the table above
- iii. Minimum no. of paddlers in the DB22 Mixed crew (excluding Drummer & Steersperson) permitted, is eighteen (18) paddlers based on the gender ratio in the table above

#### b) <u>DB12 Mixed categories:</u>

i. Permissible gender ratio for the DB12 Mixed crew, excluding Reserves:-

ii. Maximum no of paddlers in the DB12 Mixed crew (excluding Drummer & Steersperson) permitted, is ten (10) paddlers based on the gender ratio in the table above

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iii. Minimum no. of paddlers in the DB12 Mixed crew (excluding Drummer & Steersperson) permitted, is eight (8) paddlers based on the gender ratio in the table above

#### 3.4 Currency of Crew Members

- a) All crew members except steersperson (paddlers + drummer + reserves) must be an active/current member/student/full-time staff of the same organization, company, corporation, partnership, school, institution, club, association or society in year 2023.
- b) With regards to schools or learning institutions, final year students can still represent the school or institution provided their final examinations falls within the year 2023 (considered to be up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023) and they have not graduated yet (considered to HAVE NOT been awarded a diploma, degree or certificate yet).

# 3.5 <u>The Steersperson</u>

- a) For the DB12 crew, minimum Small Crew Basic Helm certification required.
- b) For the DB22 crew, minimum Basic Helm certification required.

#### c) <u>Teams from Overseas</u>

The steersperson should possess an equivalent certification from the country of origin's national sport authority and/or national association for dragon boat. If otherwise, please contact The Organizers at <a href="mailto:admin@sdba.org.sg">admin@sdba.org.sg</a>. The Organizers may approve non-certified overseas steersperson on a case-to-case basis.

# 4 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

#### 4.1 Consideration

- a) This race is open for SDBA's ordinary affiliates/associates and overseas teams.
- b) Registration shall be on a first-come-first-get basis through the SDBA's online registration system.

#### 4.2 <u>Back-to-back Races</u>

- a) Teams are advised that back-to-back races are possible. **Refer to Annex C** for the tentative Race Schedule, do note that the race schedule will only be finalized after Registration Closes.
- b) It is incumbent upon Teams to manage their own respective crew(s) and that they have sufficient number of Racers (paddlers + drummer + steersperson + reserves) for all the categories that the Team has registered in.
- c) SDBA will not allow for waiting time or concession to permit a Team that has Back-to-Back races to be ready for their next event.
- d) Upon the expiry of the prescribed calling time and the Team is still not ready, the Chief Boat Marshall will declare the said team as a 'no show' and will advise the Chief Starter to start the race without the said team.
- e) The status of the said team will then be listed as "DID NOT START" and the team will forfeit progression to the next level.

#### 4.3 <u>DB12 SRW Seniors Mixed</u>

All athletes (paddlers + reserves) must be **40 years old and above** in the event year, <u>exception is</u> made for the Drummer and/or Steersperson.

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# 4.4 <u>DB12 SRW Masters Open</u>

All athletes (paddlers + reserves) must be **50 years old and above** in the event year, <u>exception is</u> <u>made for the Drummer and/or Steersperson</u>.

4.5 The following requirements shall also apply: -

  - 7) There may be a request for doctor's diagnosis for persons with disabilities (to ensure level playing field).

#### 5 ATTIRE / UNIFORM AND RACING EQUIPMENT

- 5.1 All teams are required to be in same jersey/uniform/attire (i.e. same color, design, etc.). Rash guards, compression-wear and all types of bottoms (i.e. shorts, tights, etc.) are exempted.
- 5.2 Rental of PFD and Paddle on the race day will be charged at \$5/pc (PFD or Paddle).
- 6 RACE PROGRESSION FORMATS (for all categories, except DB22 SRW Mixed)
- 6.1 Race Format shall be:Heats -> Repechage -> Semi Final -> Final (whenever feasible) OR Direct Final.
- 6.2 Progression to the next level will be based on the following:
  - a) Finishing position achieved in the OR
  - b) Time returned in the finishing position.

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#### 7 PILOT RACE PROGRESSION FORMATS (DB22 SRW Mixed only – max of 30 crews)

#### 7.1 Race Format shall be:-

Heats -> Semi Final -> Final.

- 7.2 Progression to the next level will be based on the following:
  - a) 6 Heat Winners & 4 Fastest Losers in all Heats go to the Semi Final Platinum Tier (highest tier). Next fastest 10 crews go to Diamond Tier (2<sup>nd</sup> tier) & last 10 crews go to Gold Tier (lowest tier).
  - b) This is based on the maximum of 30 crews signed up, if the total sign-ups are less than 30, the quantum allocated to each tier may change. There shall be no elimination of crews in the Heats, elimination starts from Semi-Finals.
  - c) 2 Heat Winners & 3 Fastest Losers go to their Final in their respective Tier (i.e. Heat Winner in Semi Final 1 Gold Tier, shall qualify to the Final Gold Tier.). Rest of the crews who do not qualify to their respective Finals are then eliminated.

# 8 RACE EQUIPMENT

# 8.1 <u>Dragon Boats</u>

- a) The Organizing Committee shall provide all dragon boats, Champion IDBF 1222 Specification and Champion IDBF 912, 9.6m specification dragon boats will be used in The Event.
- b) It is the responsibility of the crew to ensure that the dragon boat and its equipment are fully functional and water worthy before departing from boat pontoon.
- c) Boats must be checked before embarking for a race, i.e. condition of seats, steering arm, stability of the drum, etc.
- d) Inform the Boat Marshall, should there be any complaints on the equipment issued.
- e) The Organizer shall not be held responsible for any boat or equipment failure once a crew had embarked and race has been started after 50 meters.
- f) Participating teams shall reimburse the Organizing Committee for any damages or losses to the equipment caused by the team concerned.
- g) The Organizing Committee has the right to change the boats depending on the availability and weather conditions.


#### 8.2 Electronic Camera Equipment/Device

- b) Team Managers must verify that they have the Up-to-date Athlete Card NUMBER of EVERY PERSON that the Team intends to register.
- c) Team Managers are required to fill-up online Form F2: Team Registration which is registration-by-numbers only. The Team Manager is required to:
  - i. indicate number of participants;
  - ii. indicate the racing category/division that the team intends to participate;
  - iii. pay extra registration fee for coxswain if the coxswain is to steer in different session/day

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# 10 WAIVERS OF LIABILITY (F4)

- 10.1 Waive of Liability form F4 is available in the online Team Registration portal after the Crew List submission is completed.
- 10.2 It is incumbent upon the Team Manager to download and print the Form F4. Team Manager must ensure that all the registered team members signed on the document. This will confirm that each registered team member is aware of their respective rights and liabilities.
- Team Managers are required to submit Form F4 on Race Day before the start of The Team's first race. Failure to submit may render The Team ineligible to compete at all in the SRW 2023.
- 10.4 Document Form F4 is a legal document so please treat the completion of this form with the utmost seriousness and importance.

#### 11 PROTESTS AND APPEALS

#### 11.1 Protests

- a) If a crew wishing to make a protest following a race, concerning the conduct of another crew, the Team Manager must lodge the protest with the Race Secretary the base of the Race Tower. Such protest must be addressed to the Competition Committee and made immediately after the race, within 10min.
- b) A protest against a race result must be made immediately after the result is officially posted, within 10min.

#### 11.2 Appeals

- a) This acknowledgement is the start of the period in which the Team Manager may appeal to the Jury, against the decision of the Competition Committee.
- b) An appeal against a protest result must be made immediately after the protest result is officially posted, within 10min.

# 11.3 Protest / Appeal Fees

- a) All protests / appeals shall be made in writing. The protest / appeal form is available at Race Sectary Station.
- b) Fees Applicable: protest/appeal Fee: \$50.
- c) The protest/appeal fee shall be refunded if the protest/appeal is successful.

- 12.5 No receipt will be issued for bank transfer payment. E-Receipt will be issued only upon request.

#### 13 ANY OTHER MATTERS

- 13.1 KASM is the co-organiser with SDBA for the SRW2023.
- 13.2 There shall be refreshments food & <u>beer</u> available for sale on the deck above the Child Care Centre by KASM. Therefore, teams coming for races are <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> to bring in their own alcoholic beverages into the Water Sports Centre (regardless of consumption). There will be bag checks at the entrance to the Back of House (where the team tents are) and teams may be requested to dispose of their alcoholic beverages if they wish to stay within the WSC premise.
- 13.3 SDBA would like to request for teams NOT to bring in their large coolers (ordered from the ice supplier) into the WSC premise as the venue will be shared by different teams in the morning/afternoon sessions. Mobile coolers on wheels or small Styrofoam boxes are permitted but they must be removed when the team leaves the venue.
- 13.4 Glass bottles are also not permitted in WSC premise as broken pieces could cut limbs when accidentally stepped onto.
- 13.5 SDBA & KASM requires all teams participating in the SRW2023 for their compliance please.

#### Annex B – SRW 2023 People's Association (PA) Rules & Regulations

- a. The Team participating in the PA GRO Open/Mixed, must belong to a grassroots organization (GRO). The registration must be endorsed by the parent GRO.
- c. A person can only be registered with one (1) PA GRO Team.

#### d. Grassroot Leader (GRL)

- i. The Team is required to register minimum one (1) GRL in their overall registration for both PA GRO Open or PA GRO Mixed category.
- ii. The GRL can either be a drummer, paddler or a steersperson.
- iii. The GRL is only required to be <u>active in only one</u> of the racing crew (i.e. either Crew A or B, etc.)
- iv. The GRL is required to produce the Grassroots card/letter from the CC they served in, to verify that the person is indeed a Grassroot Leader from the same CSN / CSC.

#### e. Minority Ethnicity

- i. The Team is required to register one (1) paddler of minority ethnicity in every racing crew in PA GRO Open and Mixed.
- ii. Minority Ethnicity refers to one (1) Malay, Indian, Caucasian or any other race who paddle in a majority Chinese paddling crew.
- iii. The Minority ethnic person must either be a Singapore Citizen or PR.

#### f. Foreigner

- i. The Team may field a maximum of one (1) foreigner in their overall registration for both PA GRO Open or PA GRO Mixed category.
- ii. The Foreigner must be a paddler only.
- iii. The Foreigner is only allowed to be <u>active in one</u> of the racing crew (i.e. either Crew A or B, for either PA GRO Open or PA GRO Mixed category etc.)
